Title

Mar 5:25-34

- 25 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years,
- 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse.
- 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind *Him* in the crowd and touched His garment.
- 28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."
- 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in *her* body that she was healed of the affliction.
- 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?"
- 31 But His disciples said to Him, "You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?' "
- 32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing.

- 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth.
- 34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."

Mar 6:56 Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.

Where did woman get the idea to touch the hem of His garment?

Num 15:37-40

37 Then the LORD said to Moses,
38 "Give the following instructions to the people of Israel: Throughout the generations to come you must make tassels for the hems of your clothing and attach them with a blue cord.

- 39 When you see the tassels, you will remember and obey all the commands of the LORD instead of following your own desires and defiling yourselves, as you are prone to do.
- 40 The tassels will help you remember that you must obey all My commands and be holy to your God.

Mal 4:2 But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves.

<u>WINGS</u> **H3671** kânâph *kaw-nawf'* an *edge* or *extremity*; specifically (of a bird or army) a *wing*, (of a garment or bed clothing) a *flap*, border, corner, end,

The seam or lower part of a garment was known as the kanap. In the "fold" (kanap; KJV, "skirt") of the garment one could carry things... (Vine's)

Mat 8:2-13

- **2** And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."
- 3 Then Jesus put out *His* hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

- **5** Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him,
- 6 saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented."
- 7 And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him."
- 8 The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.
- 9 For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this *one*, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

10 When Jesus heard *it,* He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!

13 Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.

Rom 10:6-10

- 6 But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, "DO NOT SAY IN YOUR HEART, 'WHO WILL ASCEND INTO HEAVEN?' " (that is, to bring Christ down *from above*) 7 or, " 'WHO WILL DESCEND INTO
- THE ABYSS?' " (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).
- 8 But what does it say? "THE WORD IS NEAR YOU, IN YOUR MOUTH AND IN YOUR HEART" (that is, the word of faith which we preach):

- 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
- 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
