**BLESSED** OT:835 'esher (eh'-sher);  
how happy!

Wade's def. "**Empowered to Succeed**"

**PROSPER** OT:6743 tsalach  
to push forward,

to **SUCCEED**; This word expresses the  
idea of a **successful** venture, as  
opposed to failure. (Vine's Expository  
Dictionary)

**World's Economy is based on trends  
and fluctuates with the mood of the  
market - FEAR**

**God's Economy is based on God's  
character, His Word, and Spiritual  
Laws that never change - FAITH**

**KEY #1**

**I Must Believe That It's God Will For  
Me To PROSPER**

(ref) Ps 35:27 ...**Who has pleasure in  
the prosperity of His servant."**

**PROSPERITY** OT:7965 shalom (shaw-  
lome'); or shalom (shaw-lome');  
safe, well, happy, health, prosperity,  
peace:

**Why does God want me to PROSPER?**

(ref.) Deut 8:18 "And you shall  
remember the LORD your God, for it is  
He who gives you power (wealth) to  
get wealth, **that He may establish His  
covenant** which He swore to your  
fathers, as it is this day.

**KEY #2**

**Operate the law of "Sowing and  
Reaping."**

**Seedtime and Harvest  
Sowing and Reaping  
Giving and Receiving**

**2Co 9:5-11**

**5** Therefore I thought it necessary to  
exhort the brethren to go to you  
ahead of time, and prepare your  
generous gift beforehand, which *you*  
*had* previously promised, that it may  
be ready as *a matter of* generosity and  
not as a grudging obligation.

**6** But this *I say*: He who sows sparingly  
will also reap sparingly, and he who  
sows bountifully will also reap  
bountifully.

**7** So let each one *give* as he purposes  
in his heart, not grudgingly or of  
necessity; for God loves a cheerful  
giver.

**8** And God *is* able to make all grace  
abound toward you, that you, always  
having all sufficiency in all *things*, may  
have an abundance for every good  
work.

10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness,

11 while you are enriched in everything for all **liberality**, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

**ENRICHED G4148** *ploutizō ploo-tid'-zo to make wealthy*

from G4149; *plousios*, which describes *extreme or vast material wealth*. In fact, the word *plousios* is where we get the term “plutocrat,” referring to a person who is so prosperous that he is unable to ascertain the full extent of his own wealth. ...it is impossible for his accountants and bookkeepers to keep track of how much wealth he actually possesses.

**LIBERALITY G572** *haplotēs singleness, that is, sincerity (without self seeking), generosity (copious bestowal):*

**Submit – attitude determines the measure**

### Key #3

#### Operate the Law of Genesis

##### Gen 1:11-12

**11** Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed, *and* the fruit tree *that* yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed *is* in itself, on the earth"; and it was so.

**12** And the earth brought forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed according to its kind, and the tree *that* yields fruit, whose seed *is* in itself according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good.

#### The Law of Genesis:

**Everything produces after its kind  
(life comes from life)**

**gen-e-sis** *noun (dictionary)*  
the origin or mode of formation of something.

source, root, beginning, start

**(ref.) Pro 23:7** For as he thinks in his heart, so *is* he. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, But his heart is not with you.

**This Law of Genesis can override the Promise of PROSPERITY and minimize the Law of Sowing and Reaping**

### Roots of Preconceptions

#### Mat 12:33-35

**33** "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by *its* fruit.

**35** A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things.
