KEY #1

PROSPERITY OT:7965 shalom (shaw-lome'); or shalom (shaw-lome'); safe, well, happy, health, prosperity, peace:

Why does God want me to PROSPER?

(ref.) Deut 8:18 "...He who gives you power (wealth) to get wealth, **that He may establish His covenant...**

Luke 16:10-11

KEY #2

Operate the law of "Sowing and Reaping."

2Co 9:10-11

10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness,

11 while you are enriched in everything for all **liberality**, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

ENRICHED G4148 ploutizō ploō-tid'-zo
to make wealthy

from G4149; *plousios*, which describes extreme or vast material wealth. In fact, the word *plousios* is where we get the term "plutocrat," referring to a person who is so prosperous that he is unable to ascertain the full extent of his own wealth. ...it is impossible for his accountants and bookkeepers to keep track of how much wealth he actually possesses.

LIBERALITY G572 haplotēs
singleness, that is, *sincerity* (without self seeking), *generosity* (copious bestowal):

Key #3

Operate the Law of Genesis

(ref.) Gen 1:11 ...tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed *is* in itself...

**The Law of Genesis:
Everything produces after its kind
(life comes from life)**

gen-e-sis *noun (dictionary)*
the origin or mode of formation of something.

(ref.) Pro 23:7 For as he thinks in his heart, so *is* he. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, But his heart is not with you.

This Law of Genesis can override the Promise of PROSPERITY and minimize the Law of Sowing and Reaping

(ref.) Psa 42:7 "Deep calls unto deep..."

(ref.) (MSG) "Chaos calls to chaos..."

Mat 12:33-35

33 "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by *its* fruit.

35 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things.

Mat 13:19-23

19 When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand

it, then the wicked *one* comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside.

20 But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy;

21 yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.

22 Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

23 But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands *it*, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty."

The key to a "weed-free" yard is to have a healthy yard – plant plenty of and nurture the "good" stuff

Mar 4:26-29

26 And He said, "The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground,

27 and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how.

28 For the earth yields crops by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head.

29 But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come."
