PROSPERITY OT:7965 shalowm (shaw-lo-me'); or shalom (shaw-lo-me'); safe, well, happy, health, prosperity, peace:

(ref.) Deut 8:18 "...He who gives you power (wealth) to get wealth, **that He may establish His covenant...**

Luke 16:10-11

10 He who *is* faithful in *what is* least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in *what is* least is unjust also in much.

11 Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true *riches*?

KEY #2

Operate the law of "Sowing and Reaping."

2Co 9:10-11

10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness,

11 while you are enriched in everything for all **liberality**, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

ENRICHED G4148 ploutizō *ploo-tid'-zo*
to make wealthy

from G4149; *plousios*, which describes *extreme or vast material wealth*. In fact, the word *plousios* is where we get the term "plutocrat," referring to a person who is so prosperous that he is unable to ascertain the full extent of his own wealth. ...it is impossible for his accountants and bookkeepers to keep track of how much wealth he actually possesses.

LIBERALITY G572 haplotēs
singleness, that is, *sincerity (without self seeking), generosity (copious bestowal)*:

Mat 14:15-21

15 When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Send the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food."

16 But Jesus said to them, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

17 And they said to Him, "We have here only five loaves and two fish."

18 He said, "Bring them here to Me."

19 Then He commanded the multitudes to sit down on the grass. And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitudes.

20 So they all ate and were filled, and they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments that remained.
