

Luke 4:18 "THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE HAS ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO THE POOR; HE HAS SENT ME TO HEAL THE BROKENHEARTED, TO PROCLAIM LIBERTY TO THE CAPTIVES AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET AT LIBERTY THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED;

Act 10:36-38

36 The word which *God* sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ—He is Lord of all—

37 that word you know, which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the baptism which John preached:

38 **how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.**

Jesus did not operate as God during His Earthly ministry.

Php 2:5-8

5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,

7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and coming in the likeness of men.*

8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of death*, even the death of the cross.

Jas 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

Heb 4:14-15

14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* confession.

15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are*, yet without sin.

(ref.) Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

He operated as a man anointed by God.

Isa 10:27 It shall come to pass in that day *That* his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

The ANOINTING is the yoke destroying, burden removing, power of God

John 14:12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

1Jn 2:20 But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things.

27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

The ANOINTING is a person – the HOLY SPIRIT

Mat 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.

3 Words for Healing in the Greek

#1 (90%) **HEALING G2323** *therapeuō*
From the same as **G2324**; to *wait upon* mentally, that is, (figuratively) to *adore* (God), or (specifically) to *relieve* (of disease): - cure, heal, worship.

**We get our word “Therapy”
indicating a corresponding action
(science or method)**

Act 3:6&7

6 Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."

7 And he **took** him by the right hand and lifted *him* up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.

TOOK G4084 *piazō pee-ad'-zo*
to *squeeze*, that is, *seize*, or officially [*arrest*], or in hunting [*capture*]: - apprehend, catch, lay hand on, take.

“...his feet and ankle bones received strength.”

(actual Greek “His ankle bones and steps” – the idea is that at first he could not walk, but with every step, his feet and ankle bones got stronger and stronger)

#2 **HEALING G2390** *iaomai*
to *cure* (verb)
the same Greek word for “doctor”

(ref.) **Act 10:38** how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing (*iaomai*) all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Closing

#3 **HEALING G4982** *sōzō sode'-zo*
to *save*, that is, *deliver* or *protect* (literally or figuratively): - preserve, save, do well, be (make) whole.

Wholeness – spirit, soul, and body

(ref.) **Mat 9:22**
...your faith has made you well."

21 “For she said to herself, "If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well."

22 But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well." And the woman was made well from that hour.

5 categories of sickness in the bible

#1 SICKNESS G3554 *nosos nos'-os* a This word always conveys the idea of an affliction of the most severe nature. ...a terminal illness for which there was no natural cure. (Sparkling Gems from the Greek)

Mat 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness (*nosos*) and all kinds of disease (*malakia*) among the people.

#2 DISEASE G3119 *malakia* – crippling or debilitating condition

You can live with this disease, but you can't function

#3 ILLNESS G2556 *kakos kak-os'* bad, evil, harm, ill, to be grievously vexed by demon spirits

people who were oppressed or mentally confused

Mar 5:2-9

2 And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,

3 who had *his* dwelling among the tombs; and no one could bind him, not even with chains,

4 because he had often been bound with shackles and chains. And the chains had been pulled apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces; neither could anyone tame him.

5 And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones.

6 When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him.

7 And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me."

8 For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!"

9 Then He asked him, "What is your name?" And he answered, saying, "My name is Legion; for we are many."

LEGION G3003 *legeōn leg-eh-ohn'*

A body of soldiers divided into ten cohorts, and numbering from 4,200 to 6,000 (6826)

Luke's account

Luk 8:29 "... For it had often seized him..."

SEIZE G4884 *sunarpazō soon-ar-pad'-zo*

to snatch together: - catch.

Same Greek word for epilepsy.

#4 **PLAGUE** mastigos **G3148**

(root) mastix *mas'-tix*

(literally) a *whip* (for criminals); a *disease*: - plague, scourging, torture

Mar 5:34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction (mastigos) (KJV plague). "

#5 **SICK** **G732** arrhōstos *ar'-hroce-tos*

feeble, sickly, comatose (closer to death than life)

Mar 16:18 "...they will lay hands on the sick (arrhostos), and they will recover."

Rom 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also **helps** in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

If we don't have the help of the Holy Spirit, were are:

#1 nosos - spiritually terminal

#2 malakian – spiritually cripple

#3 kakos – spiritually confused

#4 mastigos – problems keep occurring

#5 arrhostos – spiritually comatose

HELP **G4878** sunantilambanomai

soon-an-tee-lam-ban'-om-ahee

(1st time in history this word was ever used)

to *take hold of opposite together*, that is, *co-operate (assist)*: - help.

#1 *sun* - partnership (what we do together)

Position of the Holy Spirit

#2 *anti* – against (enraged)

Attitude of the Holy Spirit

#3 *lambano* – to take or receive

Desire of the Holy Spirit
